

THE ROYAL MONTREAL REGIMENT

The Royal Montreal Regiment is allied with Commonwealth forces including the West Yorkshire Regiment (The Prince of Wales' Own) of which H.R.H. the Princess Royal is the Colonel-in-Chief; the 14th Battalion, Australian Military Forces; and the Waikato Regiment, New Zealand Military Forces. The Royal Montreal Regiment was one of the first to go overseas in December 1939.

During the 1st World War, the Royal Montreal Regiment recruited troops for the 14th and 23rd Battalions, C.E.F., and earned battle honours at Ypres, 1915-17, St. Julien, Festubert, 1915, Mount Sorrel, Somme, 1916, Vimy, 1917, Passchendaele, Amiens, Drocourt-Queant and Canal du Nord. The unit went overseas as the 32nd Reconnaissance Regiment.

Regimental headquarters are at Westmount, Quebec.
