

recognizes that, according to the most elementary principles of decency, it is not up to the other political parties to decide which one of the two Social Credit groups constitutes the Social Credit party, and would leave it to the Social Credit members themselves to decide on this question by a majority vote taken among the twenty-three Social Credit members."

Mr. Speaker ruled the amendment out of order on the grounds that a Report from a Committee cannot be amended by the House, but that it must be referred back to the Committee for that purpose.

And debate continuing on the main motion,—That the Second Report of the Standing Committee on Privileges and Elections, presented to this House on Wednesday, October 9, 1963, be now concurred in;

Mr. Pickersgill, seconded by Mr. McIlraith, moved,—That the debate be now adjourned.

And the question being put on the said motion, it was agreed to on the following division:
