The following answers, deposited with the Clerk of the house, are printed in the official report of debates pursuant to standing order 39:

**TARIFF BOARD REFERENCES****Question No. 31—Mr. McIlraith:**

1. How many inquiries have been directed to the tariff board by the government for study and report under the Tariff Board Act since June 21, 1957?

2. What was the subject matter of each such study?

3. Which studies are (a) completed; (b) still before the board for hearing; (c) not yet started?

**Answer by: Hon. Donald M. Fleming (Minister of Finance):**

1. Three.

2. Reference No. 121—waterproof footwear and rubber-soled canvas footwear.

Reference No. 125—textiles; 126—fluorspar.

3. (a) Part of No. 125—wool fabrics; (b) one—No. 125; (c) none.

Note: Public hearings relating to water-proof footwear and rubber-soled canvas footwear and fluorspar have been completed but reports have not yet been made. In addition two references made prior to June 21, 1957, have not been completed.

**HIGHWAY, SUNSHINE VILLAGE, ALBERTA****Question No. 60—Mr. Hardie:**

Has the government included in its public works program the development and year-round maintenance of the road leading from the trans-Canada highway to Sunshine village, near Banff, Alberta?

**Answer by: Hon. Alvin Hamilton (Minister of Northern Affairs and National Resources):**

Provision for year-round maintenance has been made in the 1958-59 estimates. It is hoped that it will be possible to include funds in the 1959-60 estimates to permit certain reconstruction works on the road to be undertaken.
