Institute of Parasitology

Dear Col. Bovey:

For your information, I quote excerpts from the minutes of the Proceedings of the Associate Committee on Parasitology, first meeting May 17th, 1932:

Organization.

"The Committee had under consideration the form of the organization which should direct the work of the Institute. Dr. Tory explained the procedure which has been followed by the National Research Council in the appointment of various Associate Research Committees, and suggested that an Associate Committee on Parasitology might be appointed by the Council, this to be a joint Committee on which McGill University, the National Research Council and the Federal Department of Agriculture could be represented.

The function of the Committee would be to supervise the research programme and to control the work carried on at the Institute, also to deal with questions relating to the financial and general administration of the work.

It was agreed that the work should be organized under a Committee such as outlined above, and that the personnel of this Committee, be approved as follows:
