

these, together with the First Year (Arts) Exhibition Papers, shall be sent to the Registrar before February 15th.

6. The papers for the several examinations to be held in August and September (with the exception of the Matriculation Examination Papers, which are already provided for) shall be sent in before June 1st.

7. In case "copy" for any examination paper or papers should not be sent in by the dates specified, the Registrar shall be relieved of any responsibility for having the papers printed in time for the examination.

8. In the case of each examination the Registrar shall give the examiners at least a fortnight's notice of the last day for receiving "copy."

9. On receipt of the proofs, the Registrar shall at once notify the examiners in writing, addressed to the building in which they lecture, that the proofs await correction in his office. The examiners shall, within twenty-four hours after the delivery of the notification, as above mentioned, attend at the Registrar's office for the correction of the proofs.

10. After correction, the proofs shall again be handed to the Registrar with the copy. The Registrar shall file the copy and send the proofs to the printer.

11. A similar proceeding shall be followed in the case of a second or other proof being required.

12. Upon receipt of the printed Examination Papers, the Registrar shall put each set in a sealed envelope and retain it until the date of the examination, when it shall be procured from him by the invigilator appointed for that purpose by the Examination Committee.

13. The Registrar shall keep a record of the time when each "copy" is received; when it is sent to the printer; when the proofs are received from the printer; when the examiners are notified to attend and correct; when the proofs are returned to him corrected; when forwarded to the printer; when the Examination Papers are received; and to whom they are handed out for distribution.

14. At all examinations the invigilators in charge shall ask each examiner present for three corrected, initialed copies of each examination paper for which he is respon-
