## COMPOUND PHRASAL FORMS

#### PERFECT PROGRESSIVE

Present Perfect Progressive—I have been seeing, etc.

Past Perfect Progressive—I had been seeing, etc.

Future Perfect Progressive—I shall have been seeing, etc.

#### PERFECT PASSIVE

Present Perfect Passive—I have been seen, etc.

Past Perfect Passive—I had been seen, etc.

Future Perfect Passive—I shall have been seen, etc.

### PROGRESSIVE PASSIVE

Present Progressive Passive—I am being seen, etc. Past Progressive Passive—I was being seen, etc.

## INFINITIVES AND PARTICIPLES

#### GERUNDS

Simple.....seeing
Perfect.....having seen
Passive.....being seen
Perfect progressive..having been seeing
Perfect passive...having been seen

### GERUNDIAL INFINITIVES

Simple......to see
Perfect.....to have seen
Progressive....to be seeing
Passive.....to be seen
Perfect passive....to have been seen

### **PARTICIPLES**

Imperfect.....seeing
Perfect....seen
Phrasal perfect...having seen
Passive....being seen
Perfect passive...having been seen
