## COMPOUND PHRASAL FORMS

## PERFECT PROGRESSIVE

Present Perfect Progressive—I have been seeing, etc.

Past Perfect Progressive—I had been seeing, etc.

Future Perfect Progressive—I shall have been seeing, etc.

## PERFECT PASSIVE

Present Perfect Passive—I have been seen, etc.

Past Perfect Passive—I had been seen, etc.

Future Perfect Passive—I shall have been seen, etc.

## PROGRESSIVE PASSIVE

Present Progressive Passive—I am being seen, etc.

Past Progressive Passive—I was being seen, etc.

## INFINITIVES AND PARTICIPLES

## GERUNDS

Simple.....seeing

Perfect.....having seen

Passive.....being seen

Perfect progressive..having been seeing

Perfect passive.....having been seen

## GERUNDIAL INFINITIVES

Simple.....to see

Perfect.....to have seen

Progressive.....to be seeing

Passive.....to be seen

Perfect passive.....to have been seen

## PARTICIPLES

Imperfect.....seeing

Perfect.....seen

Phrasal perfect....having seen

Passive.....being seen

Perfect passive....having been seen
