From FORT WILLIAM in Scotland, to the city ST JOHN's, New Brunswick.

ON the 11th of June 1791, I set out from Fort William, and by easy stages arrived at Greenock on the 18th. Agreed with Mr James Hart, *junior*, owner of the brig Argyle, William Willie, master, for my passage to New Brunswick, in North America, at L. 18 for myself in the cabin, and L. 6 for my servant in the steerage; to be found in provisions and liquors. Here we were detained until the 2d of July, when we set sail, and found ourselves next Monday off the harbour of Lamash in Arran. Passed by Ailsa, a high and stupendous piked rock in the sea, inhabited by Solan geese, and other sea fowl. Stretch-
