

LEGISLATION TO CHECK SPREAD OF BAD WEEDS

Mr. Fisher to Bring in Bill to Amend Seed Control Act—Strongest Regulations.

OTTAWA, March 13.—Mr. Fisher will introduce a bill this session to amend the Seed Control Act and has given notice that on Wednesday next he will move the following resolution on which the legislation is to be founded:

"Resolved that it is expedient to amend the Seed Control Act by providing: (a) That the governor-in-council may make regulations determining the species of farm weeds, which shall be included within the meaning of the term 'noxious weeds'...
