The Treasurer, Mr. Masson's, accompanying statement shows that our finances are in a satisfactory condition. The ordinary collection, the monthly Missionary collection, with the balance from iast year, amount to \$162.55, by which we have been able to discharge all our obligations. The sum of \$20 was voted, last yeat, to replenish the library. The selection has not yet been made, but a committee has the matter in hand, who, it is expected, will soon have the books placed in the library. And the Congregation will be pleased to know, also, that for several years past we have maintained a pupil at the Point Aux Treple School, in connection with the French Evangelization Work, and have this year again renewed our contribution thereto, of \$50.

In conclusion, we would note our heartfelt gratitude to God for his kindness toward us in the privilege afforded so many of us, to take part in and enjoy the past seven years course of lessons study; and while we are again entering upon another seven years course of fresh and, perhaps, deeper lessons study; and while we would seek to be ready ro obey whenever the call may come to bring us to our account and rewatd, as men and women, we cannot but wish to be spared to enjoy, with fellow-woukers and pilgrims, the benefit of this course of study and service.
