Butler, Pa., Aug. 19.—More than a score of persons were injured, several seriously in a riot today between strikers of the Standard Steel Car Company's plant and non-union employees, two miles from the plant. A troop of state police, which has been guarding the works, was rushed to the scene. Upon their arrival the strikers fled from the scene. Arrests of strike leaders in connection with the riot are expected this afternoon. The strike has been in effect two weeks. More than 2,000 men are out.

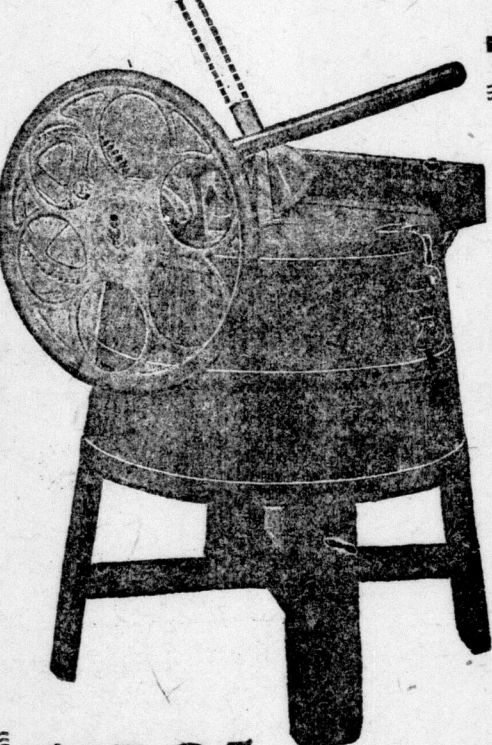

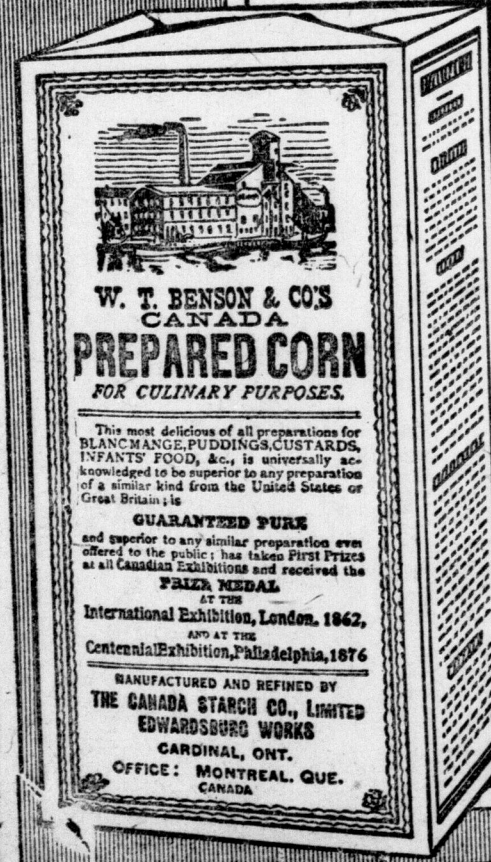
#### PIE CRUST

Take 1/2 cup flour with 1/4 cup of Benson's Corn Starch, 1/4 teaspoonful baking powder, 2 tablespoonfuls of Maltol, or butter, 1/2 cup of cold water, 1/4 teaspoonful salt. Sift flour, corn starch, and baking powder in a bowl, add shortening, rub fine through flour, add salt water and salt. Turn onto board, roll lengthwise till smooth and use as desired.

#### ORANGE CREAM PIE

Place in saucepan over the fire, 1 tablespoonful Benson's Corn Starch, 1/2 cup water, 1/4 tablespoonful of sugar and 1 tablespoonful of Lily White Corn Syrup. Boil five minutes. Remove from fire, add yolks of two eggs, 1/4 pint of an orange, and juice of one orange and 1/4 lemon; mix well, and pour into pie pan with very thin pie crust, brush out with beaten eggs and sprinkle with bread crumbs. Pour in above mixture and bake in medium oven till crust is light brown. Beat the whites of the eggs very, very stiff; add one tablespoonful of powdered sugar. Arrange by spoonfuls on top of pie and set in hot oven to brown a nice color. Serve cold.
