"Commercially, the trade with Russia, principally in liqueurs and textile goods, is growing. It has not required a Genoa Conference to initiate this trade, which has been, and will be, profitable to Poland. Her export trade of timber through Danzig has in the last two months surpassed pre-war quantities to such an extent that there is now considerable congestion at Danzig and shortage of trucks in the interior. 
