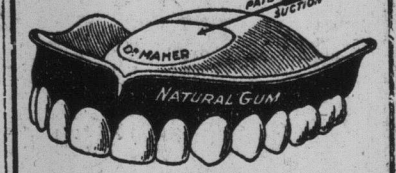
## TWO IRISH CREWS SUNK WITHOUT TRACE

Waterford a City of Mourning For The Men Who Were on the Lost Vessels

(New York Times.)

Cork, Jan. 8.—I have just returned from Waterford, which presented a spectacle of a city of mourning, women and children mourn the loss of brave Irishmen who have been ruthlessly murdered by submarine pirates—in the words of Count von Luxburg, spurious versenist. Not a single member of either of two crews is alive to tell the tale. It has been announced that a portion of wreckage and a lifeboat belonging to one of the missing boats has been washed ashore on the Welsh coast. The circumstances of the loss of the second vessel, which was sunk a few days afterward, are still a mystery. The second boat left England Dec. 17. It is supposed that when the submarine fired a torpedo, before the passengers and crew had time to launch their lifeboat or realize their fate, they went down with their ship. Few of those who have now lost their husbands and fathers will listen to this kind of talk again without doing something to silence it.
