THE STEAMER UNICORN, (carrying H. M. Mails), runs between lalifax and St. John's, Newfoundland, calling at North Sydney, Cape reton, going and returning, for freight and passengers. Leaves Halix immediately after the arrival of H. M. Steamers from Boston, uring the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, and December. During the months of January, Februry and March, the Mails are conveyed by sailing vessels.

A Steamer runs weekly during the Summer season between Annaolis and St. John, N.B., and Windsor and St. John, N. B.

THE ROYAL EASTERN STAGE COACHES run three times in the week stween Halifax and Pictou, leaving Halifax on the mornings of Tuesay, Thursday, and Saturday; and Pictou on the mornings of Monday, Vednesday, and Friday; and during the Winter twice in the week, aving Halifax on the mornings of Tuesday and Saturday, and Pictou n the mornings of Monday and Friday. Mail leaves Halifax for ictou, Amherst Bend, and St. John, N. B., on Wednesday, at halfast 5, p.m. Leaves Pictou every Thursday evening. Mails leave alifax for Pictou at same hour on Saturday. Mails arrive every riday and Monday.

A saifing Packet runs twice a week, during the Summer, between ictou and Charlottetown, P E I., leaving Pictou immediately after the rival of the Mail from Halifax, on Thursdays and Saturdays.

THE ROYAL WESTERN STAGE COACHES, (carrying H. M. Mails), in three times in the week between Halifax and Annapolis, leaving at ach place on the mornings of Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday—and etween Halifax and Windsor daily, (Sunday's excepted.)

The Parrsboro' Packet runs between Windsor, Horton, and Parrsboro', from the 1st of April till Christmas; leaving Lower Horton at after 8 o'clock on Monday for Parrsboro', and from thence to Windson Tuesday; leaving the latter place for Parrsboro' the first highater at or after 10 o'clock on Wednesday, and leaving Parrsboro' for orton on Friday.
