THE BRITISH AND NORTH AMERICAN ROYAL MAIL STEAMSHIPS, will leave during the year as follows:—

THE STEAMER UNICORN, (carrying H. M. Mails), runs between Halifax and St. John's, Newfoundland, calling at North Sydney, Cape Breton, going and returning, for freight and passengers. Leaves Halifax immediately after the arrival of H. M. Steamers from Boston, during the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, and December. During the months of January, February and March, the Mails are conveyed by sailing vessels.

A Steamer runs weekly during the Summer season between Annapolis and St. John, N.B., and Windsor and St. John, N. B.

THE ROYAL EASTERN STAGE COACHES run three times in the week between Halifax and Pictou, leaving Halifax on the mornings of Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday; and Pictou on the mornings of Monday, Wednesday, and Friday; and during the Winter twice in the week, leaving Halifax on the mornings of Tuesday and Saturday, and Pictou on the mornings of Monday and Friday. Mail leaves Halifax for Pictou, Amherst Bend, and St. John, N. B., on Wednesday, at half past 5, p.m. Leaves Pictou every Thursday evening. Mails leave Halifax for Pictou at same hour on Saturday. Mails arrive every Friday and Monday.

A sailing Packet runs twice a week, during the Summer, between Pictou and Charlottetown, P. E. I., leaving Pictou immediately after the arrival of the Mail from Halifax, on Thursdays and Saturdays.

THE ROYAL WESTERN STAGE COACHES, (carrying H. M. Mails), run three times in the week between Halifax and Annapolis, leaving at each place on the mornings of Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday—and between Halifax and Windsor daily, (Sunday's excepted.)

The Parrsboro' Packet runs between Windsor, Horton, and Parrsboro', from the 1st of April till Christmas; leaving Lower Horton at or after 8 o'clock on Monday for Parrsboro', and from thence to Windsor on Tuesday; leaving the latter place for Parrsboro' the first high-water at or after 10 o'clock on Wednesday, and leaving Parrsboro' for Horton on Friday.
