## **ADDRESS**

Of the Eighteenth Annual Conference of the Canadian Wes. leyan Methodist New Connexion Church, to the Methodist New Connexion Conference, in England.

DEAR BRETHREN.—Through the mercy of the great head of the Church, we have again been permitted to meet in our Annual Conference. Our proceedings have been characterized by Caution, Firmness, and Order. The Returns from the different Circuits, do not present so fayourable an account of our prosperity as we could wish; the past has been a year of peculiar trial and difficulty. We feel honored in being united with a body of men so liberal an scriptural in their principles as the Methodist New Connexion This Union has been productive of the most happy consequences in this country,—it is owned by the great head of the Church.
