SS-EXAMINED BY THE DEFENDING OFFICER.

- Q. 46 You say you were acting Company Sergeant, and you called the roll at 2359 hours, on the 6th of July?
- A. 46 Yes, Sir.

THE PROSECUTOR DECLINES TO RE-EXAMINE.

QUESTIONED BY THE COURT.

- Q. 47 Will you tell the Court, why the roll was called at 2359 hours, on the 6th of July?
- A. 47 At 2359 hours, on the 6th of July, the men were supposed to be back from their special leave.
- Q. 48 What was the purpose of that special leave?
- A. 48 It was their embarkation leave, Sir.
- Q. 49 Did the accused know that he was to embark?
- A. 49 Yes, Sir. They all had signed their Warning
- Q. 50 Did you hear the Warning Order read to the accused?
- A. 50 I don't remember, Sir.

In the opinion of the Court, it is not necessary to comply with R.P. 83 (B).

THE WITNESS WITHDRAWS.

THE PROSECUTOR HAS NO FURTHER WITNESSES.

THE PROSECUTION IS CLOSED.
