This reserve was left in a disgraceful state after logging operations were finished. All the tops were left lying around, and some timber left standing. This makes a serious fire hazard and I am surprised that the Forestry Department has not commented upon it. The cutting of this timber was done by Nicola Pine Mills, Ltd. of Merritt. The crops were good on this reserve.
