WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act passed in the Session Preamble.
held in the 10th and 11th years of Her Majesty's Reign, inti-
tuled "*An Act to regulate the duties between Master and Servant, and* 10, 11, V. c. 28
other purposes therein mentioned," Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts
5 as follows :

I. For and notwithstanding anything in the recited Act contained, Justices to
