BILL

To prevent the pernicious habit of . begging by Infants, and to provide for their livelihood.

THERE IS from the pernicious and immoral habits contracted Infants, found begging in this Province, who, if proper precautions were adopted might be rendered useful members of Society, it is expedient and necessary to take speedy and effectual means to prevent the recurrence of similar evils: Be it therefore enacted by the king's most Excellent Majesty by and with the consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by vutue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Butain, intituled, " An Act to repeal " certain parts of an Act passed in the four-" teenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for making more effectual provision " for the Government of the Province of Que-" bec in North America," and to make further provision for the Government of the said provision for the covernment of the said "vince;" and it is hereby enacted by the season to be taken and as often hebre a Junice as any Infant of Infants, under the age of sixteen or the reace. years, shall be found begging in any of the Roads, Success or public places in any part of the Province, it shall be lawfurfor conduct such Infant or Infants, so found begging, before any Justice of the Peace in the Definet in which such Infant or Infants shall have been found begging, which Justice of the Peace shall be. and he is hereby authorized and required to send
