# Earle Birney Speaks Friday

Free-lance movie producer and director Gerald Budner of Montreal spoke Friday evening on "Directing a Film on Art".

Mr. Budner is the second speaker to be at UNB during the university's three-week long Festival of the Arts program.

Mr. Budner outlined the steps in making a film on David Milne, starting with the reasons for selecting

Milne, through the preliminary photography, to editing the film from the "rushes", measuring and timing the numbers of frames to be used, writing the narration and the final mixing of the music and the spoken word for the film's presentation.

The Festival of the Arts is an annual UNB event which this year is sponsored by the Creative Arts Committee and

the Art Centre. Canadian architect Ronald J. Thom opened the festival last week with an address on university architecture, complementing it with an exhibition of his own university designs. The Festival's last guest will be Canadian poet Earle Birney who will read selections from his poetry on February 24 in Memorial Hall at 8:30 p.m.
