CONDITIONS: Awarded on the basis of "outstanding contribution to student life" to a student who is a member of the UNB Student Union (i.e. paid the Student Activity Fee). The recipient must be in good academic standing.
NOMINATIONS: Nominations or applicants to be received by the Dean of Students
AWARDING AGENCY: A committee formed by the Dean of students to include representation from the Undergraduate Awards Office
TIMING: Intended for presentation by the Dean of Students at the annual Student Union Awards Banquet

Nominations and applications must be in writing and describe in detail that person's "outstanding contributions to student life". While past accomplishments are significant, recent contributions will be of particular interest to the Selection Committee. To be eligible, the nominee must have been a student at UNB (i.e. paid the Student Activity Fee) this year. Consent of the nominee should be obtained by the nominator. All nominations and applications must be received at the Office of the Dean of Students, Room 8, Alumni Memorial Building by 12:00 noon on Friday, March 22, 1996.
