Uplands, Ontario	17th July/43		Cloudy to overcast. A full day's flying put in by Training Wing.	
	18th July/43		Partly cloudy. GB1612596, LAC Goody, P.W., nosed up Harvard No. 2633 when he applied brake to shorten landing run. A C-1 accident. No injury. Accident occurred at Edwards Field.	
	19th July/43		Partly cloudy. Squadron Leader H.M. Wilson (C1405)(SR)(GL) assumed Temporary Command of No. 2 S.F.T.S., Uplands, vice Group Captain A. Raymond (C621)(AAF)(GL). Command Trade Test Board convened for the purpose of Trade Testing airmen and airwomen of this Station. Section Officer Hames, Station Messing Officer, proceeded on two weeks Temporary Duty to Domaine d'Esterat, St. Marguerite's, Quebec. J9283, Flying Officer J.K. Williams, with GB1800842, LAC Crump, W.D., as student, collided with a tractor on the runway at R.1 Field, Carp. A C-2 category accident. No injury. (Harvard No. 3063). R154154, LAC Mills, allowed wing tip of Harvard No. 3108 to hit the ground while landing; applied throttle and went around again. A D-1 category accident. No injury. Accident occurred at Main Aerodrome. J14334, Flying Officer D.G. Partridge, with R175166, LAC Wright, F.F., as student, allowed Harvard No. 2830 to ground loop on landing. A B category accident. No injury. Accident took place at Main Aerodrome. R160208, LAC Coyne, J., ground looped Harvard No. 2583, when he turned off runway, at Main Aerodrome, too soon on landing. A C-1 accident.	
	20th July/43		Partly cloudy. The film, "Air Force", was presented in the Recreation Hall. Exceptionally good and well attended. GB1582328, LAC Burden, G.H., ground-looped Harvard No. BW-199 on landing at Main Aerodrome during night flying. A B category accident. No injury.	
	19th July/43	(Cont'd)	R174454, LAC Grant, A.S., taxied Harvard No. 2673 onto runway without permission and collided with a landing aircraft (Harvard No. 3805 with Flying Officer R.E. Nopper and Sgt. Whitelaw), at Main Aerodrome. Harvard No. 2673 - C-1 category; Harvard No. 3805 - C-2 category. No injury.	
	21st July/43		Clear to partly cloudy. Air Cadet Graduation. Salute was taken by the Director of Air Cadets for Canada - Group Captain D.C.M. Hume. Auditions for Major Bowes' broadcast to be held on August 5th, 1943, were heard at Rockcliffe Station. J27049, P/O G.F. Hanson, with R171908, LAC Fitzgerald, J.F., as student, allowed Harvard No. 2920 to ground loop on landing. A B category accident. No injury. At R.1 Carp.	AD
