1 § 731. *Right of labor organizations to be certified as approved*
2 *labor representatives. Upon application of any labor organization*
3 *for certification as an approved labor representative, the board*
4 *shall grant such application if it finds that the charter, constitution*
5 *and by-laws of such labor organization contain adequate provision*
6 *assuring the following rights of the members thereof and of the*
7 *applicants for membership therein:*

8 1. *That no qualified applicant shall be arbitrarily denied mem-*
9 *bership in such labor organization in the first instance; and*

10 2. *That no unreasonable conditions are imposed upon member-*
11 *ship in such labor organization; and*

12 3. *That no disciplinary proceedings shall be enforced against*
13 *any member thereof without a fair and adequate hearing held before*
14 *a duly elected committee of the labor organization; that member-*
15 *ship upon such committee is open to all members of the organiza-*
16 *tion, and that no member shall be suspended or expelled unless*
17 *approved by the votes cast, by secret ballot, of a majority of all the*
18 *members of such committee present at a regular or special meeting,*
19 *duly called after notice of the proposed action has been given to*
20 *such member; and*

21 4. *That at least once in each period of four years elections of*
22 *officers, delegates and business agents shall be held by secret*
23 *ballot at which elections all members of such labor organization in*
24 *good standing shall be entitled to equal voting rights; and*

25 5. *That annual financial statements, duly certified under oath*
26 *by one or more officers of the labor organization, are kept available*
27 *for inspection by any member thereof, and that adequate provision*
