at Botwood or the power boat at Gleneagles) for use at any of the three air bases or for safe custody at these bases. The Canadian Government agrees that no novable property is to be disposed of or removed from the air bases without the consent of the United Eingdom and Newfoundland Governments and that the proceeds of any agreed sales will be the property of those two Governments.

11. It is agreed that the Canadian Government shall not be responsible for providing marine facilities at the base on Gender Lake to be operated by the Atlantic Ferry Organization. Text ends.

Number 3. Begins. 1. Further text of proposed agreement will be forwarded in subsequent despatches which will be ready today or tomorrow. 2. Meanwhile the text of paragraph 2 subparagraph 6 now reads as follows quote, so far as practicable (A) Newfoundland personnel will be employed and (B) the present staffs at the air bases will be retained in employment. Unquote. Ends.
