

(b) Chemical Warfare Laboratories, Ottawa.

- (i) A permanent National Defence CW Research and Development Establishment closely associated with National Research Council, in order to provide facilities as recommended in Recommendation (1).
- (ii) Maintenance of minimum defensive facilities by placing existing CW Laboratory organizations under the direction of the National Research Council.
- (iii) Maintenance by Department of National Defence of a Scientific and Technical Organization operating on short term service projects.
- (iv) The formation of a small Department of National Defence arsenal for the production of limited specialized service stores not available from industry.

(c) War Disease Control Station

- (i) Maintenance of the War Disease Control Station under Department of National Defence control for the study of infectious diseases peculiar to service conditions.
- (ii) The placing of War Disease Control Station under the direction of the Associate Committee on Medical Research, National Research Council of Canada.
- (iii) The placing of War Disease Control Station under the direction of the Department of Agriculture for general research and study of diseases of cattle.

5. The foregoing submission has been considered and concurred in unanimously by the Cdn Chemical Warfare Inter-Service Board.
