With Cheques.

Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 14th instant, I transmit herewith cheques ~~Maxx~~ Nos 439 to 445 in payment of the accounts which you forwarded for relief supplies furnished to Indians of your Agency.

I have to request that in future when you forward accounts for payment you will comply with the instructions, which have already been given you, to write the name of the Band and Agency on the upper right hand corner of all Vouchers. In ~~xxxx~~^{relief} vouchers the reason for giving the supplies charged for should also be written on the face of the Voucher, in the following manner "Relief of destitute, etc". I may add that you need not get the merchants to receipt the vouchers before they are paid.
