Gentlemen:-

In reply to your letter of the 25th instant, relating to returns of timber and sawlogs cut by you last season under Licenses Nos. 3 and 3A, covering certain kinds of timber on the Garden River Limits, I beg to inform you that the specification of measurement of the square and waney timber has not been furnished.

Inclosed herewith you will receive a corrected and detailed statement showing the returns received and the balance of Crown dues payable thereunder amounting to \$78.54; also separate Licenses for the Townships of Macdonald, Laird and Meredith.

You will be good enough to transmit the specification of measurement of each piece of square and waney timber cut under each of the Licenses in order that it may be examined and certified in the usual way.

The questions of disposition of the timber seized and rights of settlers to cut timber within your Limits remain in abeyance.
