
CIRCULAR

It is desired that you will inform all Indians in your agency that they are subject to the Game Laws of the Province of Manitoba, and that it is the wish of the Department that they will assist in accomplishing the end for which the laws have been framed, that is the protection of the larger game and of the fur-bearing animals, a matter of vital importance to the Indians.

Be good enough to impress upon your Indian the necessity for their loyal observance of the laws and regulations of the Province.
