to call her - said first Mrs Perill, then Mrs Wilcox. She said, call me
"Matty": we knew, she then spoke to her mother about not worrying
and went on to tell her mother that there was no such thing
as reincarnation; that everything was progression, that reincarna-
-tion was retrogression, returning to a lower order of things; that
she had learned a lot since she had learned with the Spirit world.
That there was nothing to fear - She said something about
never being separated but once, that families go on
(Mrs Fulford explained to me afterwards that some one had
told her that her reincarnations would be, to suffer poverty -
she had been worrying about it - or wondering about it;
it was clear Matty knew what was in her mind and was
bringing her the comfort of the certainty of continuance with
her loved ones, and no separation, or any farther return, all
a progression onward and onward, - Mrs Fulford spoke of the Bible
story, she was told that she was being well looked after, but it was intimated
it would not be possible for her to speak at present.
