FOURTH WITNESS:

8D-135946 CPL LAMPITT, J.I., QUEBEC COMMAND PROVOST COY., CANADIAN PROVOST CORPS, MONTREAL, P.Q., having been duly sworn, states:

" I am attached to Quebec Command Provost Section and on 5 Oct 49 I was instructed by Major Rochon, A.P.M., Quebec Command, to go to Queen Mary Veterans' Hospital and contact WO II Rowe, as Pte Laplante would be reporting there and to take him into custody. I proceeded to Queen Mary Veterans' Hospital and arrived there at 1350 hrs the same date and contacted WO II Rowe. WO II Rowe informed me that Pte Laplante had not yet appeared, explaining to me that he would be going through a medical examination and, if found to be ill, he would be admitted to the hospital. He told me to return to H.Q. and if Pte Laplante appeared he would put him through the medical and inform me of the results. When I returned to Headquarters I was told to return to the hospital, that Pte Laplante had appeared. I returned to the hospital and again contacted WO II Rowe, who told me that Pte Laplante was at present going through his medical in the M.I.R. I proceeded to the M.I.R. and waited at the door, as it was closed. Soon after a man came out and I asked him if he was Pte Laplante. He said yes. I apprehended him at 1415 hrs, 5 Oct 49, and kept him under observation while he was going through his X-Rays.

Before taking him back to Headquarters, I again contacted WO II Rowe, who informed me that Pte Laplante would not be admitted to the hospital. I escorted Pte Laplante to Headquarters and later escorted him to the guard room at No. 25 Central Ordnance Depot, Longue Pointe. I received a receipt
