XXVII.

Every Ordinance or Bye-Law shall be read twice before it is committed and engrossed, and read a third time before it is signed by the Mayor.

XXVIII.

No Ordinance brought into the Council shall have more than one reading on the same day.

XXIX.

The Mayor shall cause the Clerk to make a list of all Ordinances, Resolutions, or Reports on the the Table, which shall be considered "The general order of the day"—original communications and petitions shall be first taken up, then any unfinished subject, then the special orders of the day, unless the Council shall decide differently.

XXX.

Committees shall be appointed on motion of a Member by consent of a majority of the Council. Committees appointed to report on any subject referred to them by the Council, shall report a statement of facts, and also their opinion thereon, in writing, and no report shall be received unless the same shall be signed by a majority of the Committee.

Every Petition, Remonstrance, or other written Application intended to be presented to the Common
