ECLIPSES.

In the year 1887, there will be four eclipses, two of the sun and two of the moon.

- I.—A partial eclipse of the moon, February 8th, visible in North America, beginning at 4 h. morn., and ending at 6 h. 03 m. morn., Montreal time.
- II.—An Annular Eclipse of the Sun, February 22nd, invisible in Canada; visible in South America and the South Pacific Ocean.
- III.—A partial eclipse of the Moon, August 3rd, invisible in Canada.
- IV.—A total eclipse of the Sun, Aug. 19th, invisible in the inhabited portion of Canada.
