Society, for the furthering of its ends and the carrying out of its objects.

6. In the event of a vacancy occurring in this Committee, the remaining members thereof shall have power to fill such vacancy.

COMMITTEE.

7 The Committee, of which five shall form a quorum, shall have charge of and control all the affairs of the Society, and shall decide all questions that arise affecting the interests, objects or work of the Society.

8. The Committee shall have control of the funds of the Society, and shall cause to be prepared annually a detailed statement of the condition of the Society, showing its receipts and disbursements, and summarising the work done during the year, which shall be submitted at the annual general meeting.

9. The Committee may convene a special general meeting of the Society at any time.

AUDITORS.

10. Two Auditors shall be elected at the annual general meeting, to examine the current year's accounts and to report thereon at the next annual general meeting.

ADMISSION.

11. Applications for membership shall be in writing addressed to the Secretary, signed by the applicant, and shall be accompanied by the recommendation of a member and by the sum of one dollar, being the membership fee for the current year.
