

Bye Laws before confirmed to be published four weeks and proof thereof made.

That all Bye Laws or Ordinances, before they shall be sent up to His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, and Council, for their confirmation, shall be published in one of the Newspapers of the City, at least four weeks before the same shall be so sent ; which publication shall be proved to the satisfaction of the Lieutenant-Governor and Council, before such confirmation shall be given.

Limitation.

VI. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall continue and be in force for the term of ten years and no longer.

CAP. V.

An Act to continue until the first day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty, certain Acts providing for the more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John, and to amend the same.

Passed 5th April, 1828.

I. **B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That an Act passed in the fiftieth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled
 “ An Act to provide for the more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John ; and also a certain other Act passed in the fifty-eighth year of the Reign of His late Majesty, intituled “ An Act further to continue and to amend an Act to provide for the more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John,”
 so far as the same are now in force, continue and remain in full force until the first day of April, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty ; excepting nevertheless as the same are hereby altered and amended.

Continued till 1st April, 1830.

II. *And whereas* in and by the second Section of the said first recited Act, it is enacted that the
