By His Excellency

SIR JOHN WENTWORTH, Baronet, L. L. D.

Lieutenant-Governor and Commander in Chief, in and over His Majesty's Province of Nova-Scotia, and its Dependencies, &c. &c.

WHEREAS the General Affembly of this Province stands prorogued to Thurfday the 16th Day of April next.

I have therefore thought fit further to prorogue the faid General Affembly to Tuefday the 9th Day of June next, then to meet for the Difpatch of Bufinefs; of which all Perfons concerned, are hereby required to take notice, and govern themfelves accordingly.
