The Clerk informed the Members that, fince the last Meeting of the House in General Assembly, Simon B. Robie, Esq. His Majesty's Solicitor-General, the Speaker of the House, has been appointed a Member of His Majesty's Council, and taken his Seat at that Board; and thereupon,

Resolved, That the Seat of the faid Simon B. Robie, Esq. Reprefentative for the County of Halifax, and the Speaker of the Houfe, be vacant by his appointment to a Seat in His Majesty's Council,; and that the Clerk do inform His Honor the Prefident, that, in confequence, the Houle are at prefent without a Speaker.

A Meffage was delivered from His Honor the President, by Mr. Deputy-Secretary Hill, commanding the attendance of the Members in the Council Chamber.
