Ordered, That the Petition of *Thomas L. Wilson*, of the City of *Ottawa*, presented this day, be now received and read.

And the said Petition was received and read; praying that the House will subscribe for a certain number of copies of a work, intituled: "*Life and times of Lord Palmerston*."

Ordered, That the Petition of *Thomas L. Wilson*, of the City of *Ottawa*, be referred to the Joint Committee of both Houses on the Library.

Ordered, That the Petition of *C. S. Rodier* and others, of the City of *Montreal*, presented this day, be now received and read.

And the said Petition was received and read; praying for an Act to incorporate them under the name and style of "*Caisse d'Epargne de la Section St. Joseph de la Société de Tempérance de Montréal*."

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the following Petitions were read:—

Of the Local Municipality of *Bury, Canada East*; praying that the arrears of interest due to them under the Seigniorial Act of 1859, may be paid them.

Of *John Benson* and others; and of *R. W. Lowery* and others, both of the Township of *Albion*,—and of the Municipality of the Township of *Chinguacousy*, all of the County of *Peel*; severally praying that the Act passed in the 20th *Victoria*, cap. 156, incorporating the *Toronto* and *Owen Sound* Central Railway Company, may be revived.

Of *A. Carman* and others, of the City of *Ottawa*; praying for the passing of an Act to amend the Act incorporating the *Belleville* Seminary, and to change the name to "*Albert College*."

Of Messrs. *C. S. Gzowski* and *D. L. Macpherson*, of the City of *Ottawa*; praying for the passing of an Act authorizing the issue of Letters Patent to them, for a certain invention for improvements in treating certain ores and alloys, and in obtaining metals and other products therefrom.

Of the Reverend *G. V. Houseman*, Rector of *Quebec*; praying that the Bill to remove doubts as to the legality of a Canon of the Synod of the Diocese of *Quebec*, respecting the Parish and Chapelries of *Quebec*, may not become law.

Of *John Noble* and others, of the Counties of *Middlesex*, *Huron* and *Perth*; praying that certain lands belonging to the *Canada* Company, may be withdrawn and sold to actual settlers.

The Honorable Mr. *Cameron* (*Peel*), from the Standing Committee on Miscellaneous Private Bills, presented to the House the Fourteenth Report of the said Committee, which was read, as followeth:—

Your Committee have considered the following Bills, and have prepared certain amendments to each, which they submit for the consideration of Your Honorable House:—

Bill, to incorporate the *St. Patrick's Hall* Association of *Montreal*.

Bill, to amend the Act incorporating the City of *Three Rivers*.

They have considered the Bill to erect the Township of *Clifton* into two separate municipalities, and find the preamble not proven, as there is so much difference of opinion in the locality, as, in the opinion of Your Committee, to render legislation inexpedient.

The Honorable Mr. Attorney General *Cartier*, from the Standing Committee on Railways, Canals and Telegraph Lines, presented to the House the Sixth Report of the said Committee, which was read, as followeth:—

Your Committee have considered the Bill to extend the period for the completion of the works of the North Shore Railway and *St. Maurice* Land and Navigation Company;
