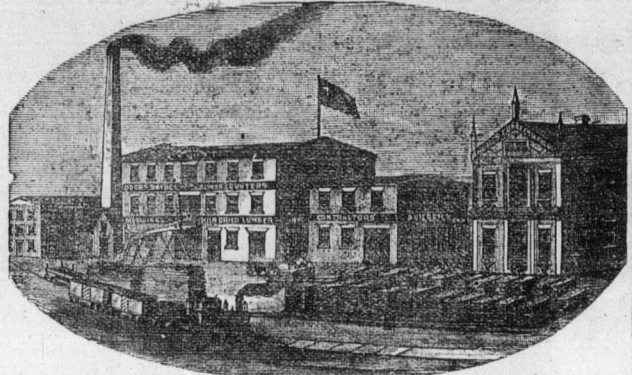

The shipment of a raft of logs from St. John, N. B. to New York, last spring, demonstrated the feasibility of shipping logs on the ocean. It is proposed to discount this feat by undertaking the shipment of a similar raft from Galveston, Texas, to London as an experiment. It is believed that a long raft from Galveston to London would not encounter the severe storms and ice incident to the coast from the Bay of Fundy to New York harbor. The raft will be in readiness to start from Galveston late in July of next year. The raft is to consist of Texas yellow pine, and is intended for ship and house building. If the experiment proves a failure the loss will be about \$20,000.
