WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

THE sole head of a family, or any mal THE sole head of a family, or any male I over 18 years old, may homestead, at guarter-section of available botton iand in Manitoba, Suskatchewan or ol-berta. The applicant must appear in-person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be wade at the office of any Local Agent or Dominion Lands (not sub-fagent), on certain conditions. Duties-Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of the three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on at farm of at least 80 acres, on certain con-ditions. 
