

Portuguese Regulations.

DECLARATION OF CARGO VALUES ARE CALLED FOR.

Arriving from Oporto under date of 15th. says to-day's issue of the Review, Messrs. J. T. Costa & Co. send the following information regarding new regulations just adopted by the Portuguese Government:

We consider it to your advantage to acquaint you of a decree No. 7399 of the Portuguese Government concerning the shipment of goods in general and in foreign ports and to Portugal, says our correspondents.

The said decree the quantity of goods inserted in each Bill of Lading must be provided with a "Declaração de Carga" (Declaration of cargo) in triplicate, signed by the shipper and vided by the Portuguese Consul at the port where vessel comes to anchor. It may be written in Portuguese, French, English, Spanish or Italian, the right value of the merchandise must be inserted there, and the fees chargeable by the Portuguese Consul for this document are 10 per cent on fish cargoes upon their receipt.

A receiver or consignee of a cargo presenting Bills of Lading at the Custom House of the destination without the corresponding Consul's declaration, is fined with the double (200 per cent) of the value of goods.

When the value declared is found to be inferior to the right value, the Custom House at the port of destination will collect the difference due to the Portuguese State.

When the vessel proceeds from a port where there is no Portuguese consul, a declaration of cargo certified by the Newfoundland Custom House at the port of loading has been in discussion, and the fees of 2 per cent, which should have been paid at the loading port, are collectable at the port of destination.

Two per cent is the maximum of Consul fees as per Government tariff, in which fish is included, but there are other articles of merchandise where the Consul tax is between 1/2 per cent. to 1 per cent.

A sound fine, complication at the Custom House at the port of destination and detention to ships, a legalization of the Consul's declaration could be brought by the vessel containing the goods.

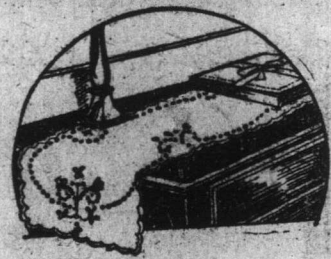
