

## Proceedings of the Synod

June 28, 1922.

## AFTERNOON SESSION.

The House met at 3.30, the Lord Bishop presiding, and reading the opening prayers.

The minutes of the previous session were read and confirmed.

Rev. Canon Bolt moved the Report of the Ordination Candidates Council, which on being duly seconded was adopted.

Rev. Canon Bolt moved the adoption of the Report of the Managers of the Diocesan Sustentation Fund, which on being duly seconded was agreed.

Mr. J. J. Long gave notice to ask Mr. Brian Dunfield to lay on the table of the House all correspondence relating to the employment of the staff of Bishop Spencer College, the dismissal, retirement or resignation of any member of the staff, also the Minutes of the Board of Directors relating to the same and any report of Miss Richards relative to the teaching staff for the good and future welfare of the College. The above correspondence, etc., to be from the time Miss Richards was appointed Headmistress of Bishop Spencer College up to the time of her resignation.

Rev. J. T. Richards gave notice that he would on to-morrow draw the attention of the Synod to the work of Dr. Grenfell in Northern Newfoundland and Labrador, and move a resolution.

The House resumed its debate on the adoption of the Report of the Literature Committee. Several members expressed opinions of the very satisfactory character of the Diocesan Magazine under its new management, and of its increasing usefulness to church people. The main problem in connection with the Magazine is, however, the problem of financing it, and a suggestion was thrown out that a limited liability company be formed to carry on this useful Diocesan publication. At this stage the Report of the Literature Committee was adopted.

Rev. Canon Bayly then moved and it was duly seconded that a Select Committee be appointed to consider this question of the formation of a limited liability company in connection with the Magazine, and to report at as early a date as possible to this Synod. Agreed. The Committee nominated and approved by the House comprise the following, viz: Rev. Canon Smart, Canon Bayly, Messrs. G. J. Adams, A. L. Barrett, Geo. J. Bartlett. Pursuant to notice, Dr. Blackall moved his resolution that the Synod request the Legislature to increase the number of Directors of the Church of England Colleges, so that representatives from the outports and women may be introduced; and that a Bill may be introduced into this Synod to give effect to this resolution. On being seconded the motion was put to the House, and on division was lost.

The House resumed the debate on the motion of Rev. W. R. J. Higgit relating to the question of the enforcement of law and order especially in connection with the Prohibition Act, and of the Resolution in an amendment by Rev. J. T. Hiscock, to ask the Government for a referendum on this question. The matter was debated by many members until the closing hour, when on motion, seconded and carried, the whole subject was deferred.

On motion, duly seconded, the House adjourned.

## EVENING SESSION.

The House resumed at 8 o'clock.

The Select Committee appointed in connection with the proposed amendment to Chap. I and Chap. VII of the Constitution and Rules concerning the franchise to women, reported that: "Having considered the matter to which they were entrusted the Committee are of opinion that the qualification for speaking and voting should be the same for women as for men."

On motion, duly seconded, the Report was adopted.

Rev. Canon Jeeves moved the House into committee of the whole on the Report on the Bill brought in by the Select Committee. On being seconded this was agreed.

The House went into Committee.

It was moved, seconded and carried that the report be adopted. Agreed.

It was moved, seconded and carried that the committee rise and report the Bill passed without amendment.

The Committee rose and the House resumed.

Canon Jeeves gave notice that he would on to-morrow move that the bill be read a third time and passed.

The House resumed its debate on the adoption of the report of the Executive Committee of the Synod, of which His Lordship the Bishop gave notice last evening, and appointed Messrs. W. N. Gray, George House, C. B. Dicks and W. J. Martin to be scrutineers. At 10 o'clock the scrutineers presented the result of the election to His Lordship the Bishop, who announced that the following had been elected and that the Executive during the coming Biennial period would comprise: His Lordship, viz: His Lordship, the Bishop, ex officio; Rev. 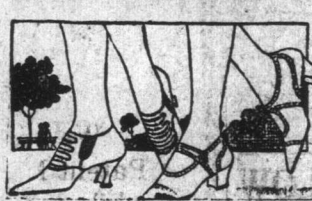
