

Beets have been grown weighing 9 pounds each; carrots, 6 pounds; red cabbage, 22 pounds; green cabbage, 18 pounds, and pumpkins, 50 pounds. Potatoes, onions, melons of all kinds, tomatoes, citrons and cucumbers were a great success and the early ones ripened well. Small fruits bore exceedingly large crops, and, in fact, everything planted so far has returned a rich harvest. Mineral is not the only wealth of the Slocan.
