**THE POLICE AND THE PRAOP.**  
Toronto has a creditable and on the  
whole intelligent police force. The men  
are civil and do not often lose their ten-  
per. But a student is the one thing that  
seems to act as a red rag to the police bull.  
We do not wish to apologize for any bad  
conduct students may be guilty of, or to  
encourage them in their pranks. But we  
wish to suggest to the policemen that show  
all things they keep their temper in dealing  
with the "golden youth" in their midnight  
movements. Toronto has become a univer-  
sity city—a large commercial city with a  
dozen colleges right in its midst, and as a  
consequence has attracted at least two  
thousand young men or more to study the  
winter through. In all this bubbling mass  
of youth there is bound to be an overflow,  
to be lots of young hot-heads and some-  
times offence. But the policeman should  
be cool, should bear or put up with a great deal—be  
almost long-suffering. That is what he is for.  
He should not be punk to the youthful leader-  
box. If a young man wishes to sing at  
midnight he ought to be suppressed, but  
suppressed in a good-natured way. A firm,  
respectful address from an officer of the  
law ought to be sufficient; a hasty, over-  
bearing command coupled with an appeal  
to the club will only breed bad blood, and  
once a feud springs up between the two it  
will take years to remove it. We've got  
to get more in the way of European univer-  
sity cities in settling these little "street  
episodes." A student when he gets in "a  
muss" should always be gentleman enough  
to give his name and address to the officers;  
they do it in Berlin and Paris, and thus  
save a night's sleep in the lock-up, and in  
this way "sent for" next day they put in  
an appearance. An American writer, speak-  
ing the other day of the London police, said,  
"We have come to regard every one of  
them as our friends." And that is the  
true conception that a policeman should  
form of his duties; he is the public friend  
of all but thieves and thugs. And the  
sooner any young man who is inclined to be  
noisy gets a similar idea in his head the  
better it will be for him.

**THE GLOBE OF THE PARSON'S PETITION.**  
The Globe of Thursday has an exhibit  
of remarkable ability and logical power on  
the proposed compulsory religious educa-  
tion. It proves from statistics, in the first  
place, that under the existing school sys-  
tem the bible is read daily in seven-eighths  
of the public schools of Ontario. It then  
shows that the clerical proposal would in  
effect establish a compulsory religious test  
for teachers, and would thus bring us back  
from our present state of civil and religious  
liberty to the old evils of state churchism.  
The Globe then states the grave objections  
to the sacred book being made a school  
text-book. It contains much not meant for  
the ears of boys and girls, much that is  
unfit for a school. If read it must be  
explained. This would bring a conflict  
between the churches, and all sorts of  
jealousies with trustees of different denom-  
inations. In fine, it most justly gives up  
the question by stating that the clerical  
proposal would be a disaster: we may add  
on our part that as we said in The  
World a few days ago, there is no  
presumption, but rather the contrary, that  
the proposal in question represents the  
laity or anyone but the reverend gentlemen  
themselves.

**AN ILLOGICAL POSITION.**
