#### MEETING OF SYNOD.

The Annual Meeting of the Synod of the Presbyterian Church of Canada will be held (D. V.) in the City of Toronto, and within Know's Church, on Wednesday, the 14th day of June, 1654, at Three o, clock, p. m., and will be opened with Sernion as usual.

#### TO PRESBYTERY CLERKS.

Presbytery Clerks are carnestly requested to forward to the Rev. WM. Rein, Toronto, the Clerk of the Synod, eight days before the meeting of Synod, Rolls of their respective Presbyteries, so that the Synod Roll may be made up at the commencement of the Session:

Presbytery Clerks dre also requested to forword to the Synod, the necessary certificates and extracts with reference to such Students of Divinity, as may be proposed for being taken on trials for license.

Presbyteries will be expected to report their approval or disapproval of the explanatory clause. proposed to be adopted, with reference to certrin passages in the Confession of Faith.

Presbyteries are also directed to report to the Synod, such congregations as have continued to neglect the stated collections.

Presbyterics are required by the Synod, to present written reports on the subject of religion within their bounds.

Presbytery Clerks are required by the Synod to prepare and forward condensed reports of all cases of license, ordination, induction, deposi-tion and death of ministers, within the bounds of the several Presbyteries during the year.

It is desirable that all Overtures, References, Petitions; and other papers to be laid before the Synod; be forwarded as early as possible, so that the business of the Synod may be properly arranged.

Kirk Sessions are reminded that if one of their own number cannot attend the meeting of Synod, they may cleet one connected with another congregation.
