## ARTICLE V

The present Protocol shall come into force on the date on which two of more States shall have become Parties thereto.

The amendments set forth in the annex to the present Protocol shall combinto force when fifteen States have become Parties to the present Protocol, and consequently any State becoming a Party to the Convention, after the amendments thereto have come into force, shall become a Party to the Convention as amended.

## ARTICLE VI

In accordance with paragraph 1 of Article 102 of the Charter of the United Nations and the regulations pursuant thereto adopted by the General Assembly the Secretary-General of the United Nations is authorized to effect registration of this Protocol and of the amendments made to the Convention by the present Protocol on the respective dates of their entry into force, and to publish the Protocol and the revised text of the Convention of 14 December 1928 relating to Economic Statistics as soon as possible after registration.

## ARTICLE VII

The present Protocol, of which the Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish texts are equally authentic, shall be deposited in the archives of the United Nations Secretariat. The Convention to be amended in accordance with the annex being in the English and French languages only, the English and French texts of the annex shall be equally authentic texts and the Chinese Russian and Spanish texts shall be translations. A certified copy of the Protocolincluding the annex, shall be sent by the Secretary-General to each of the States Parties to the Convention of 14 December 1928, relating to Economic Statistics as well as to all States Members of the United Nations.

In faith whereof the undersigned, being duly authorized thereto by their cespective Governments, signed the present Protocol on the date appearing apposite their respective signatures.

Done at Paris this 9th day of December one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.
