I have the honour to forward herewith five copies in English and five in French of the Third Interim Report of the International Commission for Supervision and Control in Vietnam on the progress of implementation of the Agreement on the Cessation of Hostilities in Vietnam during the period 11th February to 10th April 1955.

2. Twelve spare copies (English and French) of the Report are enclosed for distribution to members of the Geneva Conference as decided by the co-Chairmen on the First Interim Report.

While the Indian and Polish Delegates on the Commission consider that the Third Interim Report should be submitted in the same way as the two previous interim Reports, the Canadian Delegate on the Commission is of the view that the attention of the co-Chairmen should be specifically drawn to certain aspects of the Report - copy of a note by the Canadian Delegation on this subject is attached.
