Your Excellency

I have the honour to refer to recent discussions between officials of the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Canada concerning transport assistance by Canadian armed forces to the election observers in Southern Rhodesia. These discussions have led to an Agreement on the basis of the terms and conditions set forth in the Annex to this Note.

If the terms and conditions set out in the Annex are acceptable to the Government of Canada, I have the honour to propose that this Note and its Annex, together with Your Excellency's reply to that effect, shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall be deemed to have entered into force on 9 February 1980.
