

CONVENTION ON SOCIAL SECURITY

BETWEEN

CANADA AND LUXEMBOURG

Canada

and

the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg,

Resolved to co-operate in the field of social security,

Have decided to conclude a convention, and

Have designated, to that effect, as their plenipotentiaries:

for Canada,

the Minister of National Health and Welfare,

and

for the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg,

the Minister for Social Security,

Who, after exchanging their full powers, found in good and due form,

Have agreed as follows:

PART I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

1. For the purposes of this Convention,
  - (a) "legislation" means the laws and regulations specified in Article II;
  - (b) "competent authority" means, as regards Canada, the Minister of Ministers responsible for the administration of the legislation of Canada; and, as regards Luxembourg, the Minister or Ministers who have in their area of responsibility the legislation specified in Article II;
  - (c) "competent institution" means, as regards Canada, the competent authority; and, as regards Luxembourg, the institution to which the person
