As the hon. member for York East said, an attempt was made by the government in the first instance to deal with these trading and proxy problems in the light of the increasing sophistication of modern corporations. But by the time the legislation had moved from the House of Commons to the committee and back, and into the Senate and back, its original purpose had been defeated. I call upon the strong and free members of the Liberal party to stand up and vote against this bill. Let them pay no attention to the hon. member for York East. Even though he does speak eloquently, he has not the courage or the strength to vote against this measure. But I would expect other hon. members, more especially those from Toronto who know what happens on Bay Street and who are familiar with the corporate chicanery which prevails, to refuse to fall in and follow the weak shadow boxing champion of Canada, the Minister of Consumer and Corporate Affairs.
